When you **ADOPT A ROOM** at one of our Atlanta Ronald McDonald Houses, you are providing more than a place to sleep. You make it easier for children to receive the life-saving care they need and keep their families close by, every step of the way.

By adopting a room, you help ensure a comfortable place for families to be together. Your sponsorship provides operating support that offsets the costs of housing families, such as utilities, linens and cleaning, as well as annual repairs like paint or carpet tiles.

In 2024, ARMHC's House Program served more than 1,500 unique families, with an average stay of 8 nights. Only 16% of these guests were able to afford any contribution toward their stay. Demand for services continues to rise, with occupancy running at capacity.

Studies show that children heal better and faster when their families can be with them during treatment and recovery. The lasting impact of the **ADOPT-A-ROOM Program** and our Houses include improved medical outcomes, reduced financial burden, and expanded networks of support.
